To ensure safety of our students and a successful partnership, the CHIJ CPC requests that our parent volunteers observe these important guidelines:

ON IMAGE

- 1. PVs should project a **positive image** of the school and uphold the **CHRIST values** of CHIJ Primary.
- 2. PVs should always be mindful that we present ourselves as **good** role models to our children in attitude, conduct, and appearance.
- 3. PVs must **dress modestly and appropriately** when volunteering at school events/duty.

ON CONDUCT

- 1. PVs are to follow the school's rules and respect the authority of the school.
- 2. PVs should be ready and willing to help in a different class/play area if there is a shortage of manpower on the day of a PV activity.
- 3. PVs must be **impartial and fair** in their dealings with the students; PVs should not get involved in squabbles between children especially those involving their child.
- 4. PVs must not use their duty time in school for informal Parent-Teacher meetings. Should a PV need to meet with any teacher regarding their child, an appointment should be made to see the teacher based on the procedures set out by the school.



ON SECURITY

- 1. PVs are allowed to **be in school strictly** only on the day(s) and **during** the time(s) of duty.
- 2. When volunteering, PVs must **prominently display the PV passes** provided when in school for duty. PVs who are not on duty must not use the PV passes and should instead obtain a Visitor's Pass from the Security Post.
- 3. When in school for duty, PVs must make their way directly to the assigned duty areas and remain there until the end of duty time.

 At no time should PVs venture to any other parts of the school.





ON PRIVACY

PVs must always respect the confidentiality and privacy of all members of the school. In this regard, PVs must not:

- Take photographs and/or videos on the school premises except with prior approval granted by authorised school personnel.
- Post/Share any photographs and/or videos taken on the school premises on any social media platform.
- X Discuss or divulge any information or activities that occur in school;
- We their position as a PV to promote any commercial products or political candidates or parties.





PV CONSENT

- I hereby fully understand, accept, and acknowledge that by participating, registering my interest, and providing the information required on any forms, or other communication channels such as WhatsApp. I give my consent to CHIJ Primary and CHIJ Central Parents Council (CHIJ CPC), its appointed partners and agents, to collect, use and disclose my data for the sole purpose of media and communicating with me, either individually or as a group. I consent to being added to group email lists and WhatsApp group chats and understand that my email address and/or mobile number will be visible to other PVs. I understand that I can withdraw my consent at any time by emailing chijpri.cpc@gmail.com but such withdrawal will take up to 7 days to take effect.
- I understand that the filling up of PV forms does not guarantee the slot(s) or class that I have signed up for.
- By participating in the event, I understand that photography and videography may be conducted during the Event, Programmes, and consent to CHIJ Primary, Central Parents Council, its appointed partners, and agents taking photographs and videos of me/my child and using the same for event reporting, marketing, publicity, and media/social media on the school's platform.
