## Mix, Match and More

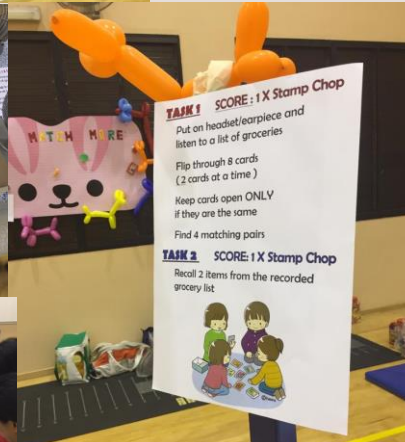
Children's Day is always magical at IJ Primary and this year was no different!
